
MARWARI YUVA MANCH, BARPETA ROAD BRANCH,

The MoU between the First and Second Party contains the following:

The B.H. College, Howly, Assam, India is a College with potential for Excellence established in 1966. The B. H. College and the MARWARI YUVA MANCH, BARPETA ROAD BRANCH, seek to promote development of corporative relationship between them. The Principal, B. H, College and Chairman/Secretary, MARWARI YUVA MANCH, BARPETA ROAD BRANCH, hereby agree to enter into this non-binding Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), that enables to work together for building the Educational Partnership between the two institutions/organization. AND WHEREAS it is found to be more beneficial and convenient to carry out the said objectives between the parties hereto and therefore, the parties have agreed to enter into this MoU under the following conditions.



- 1) The B. H. College and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch, based upon principles of respect for independence and mutual benefits, shall strongly encourage the following activities:
 - a. Co-organization of and participation in Seminar and academic meetings;
- b. Cooperate in the Health Camps, Blood Donation Camps and in other heath and hygiene related programme from time to time;
 - c. Cooperate in providing services to College Girls Common room and women Hostel etc.
 - d. Cooperate and conducting various Students Centric Development programmes like, QUIZE Competitions, DEBATE Competitions, Motivational Lectures, Career Counseling etc. from time to time.
- 2) Any activities mentioned above shall be organized and implemented by the **B. H. College** and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch, in due consideration of the following principles:
 - a. Consistent with the policies and the mission of B. H. College and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch.
 - b. In accordance with the policies and the mission of Commerce Forum, B. H. College and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch,, "the right of intellectual property", 'freedom of information and protection of privacy" of respective geographical area.
- 3) The B. H. College and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch, Howly, shall be responsible for overall implementation of the MoU.



- 3) Each side shall bear its own costs and expenses arising from this MoU unless otherwise mutually arranged and agreed to.
- 4) The MoU shall be operational with the approval by appropriate Governing Boby/Management committee of their respective institutions.
- 5) Disputes with regard to interpretation of any or all clauses shall be settled by the two nodal authorities. Failing an agreement of the two, a committee having three representatives of each institution nominated by the respective institution, shall resolve the issue in joint meeting(s). The committee shall have the power to recommend modification, annulment, addition, substitution of any clause and/or issue explanatory memorandum that will form part of the MoU.
- 6) Matters not covered under this MoU shall be open for incorporation from time to time subject to mutual consensus of the competent authorities of the two institutions.
- 7) This MoU shall take effect on the date of signatures by the representatives of both the institutions/departments and shall be valid for the period of Five (5) years.
- 8) Either side may terminate this MoU prior to the expiry term with written notice to the other side. Any programs and/or projects in progress at the time termination of this MoU shall remain unaffected.
 - For each assignment of work to be undertaken by the, B. H. College and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch,, under this MoU, the extent of skills and expertise by each of the said institution/department and fee for skills and expertise and faculties to be provided and the terms of payment shall be as per rules of the institutions/departments and in case the skill or expertise is not available it shall be negotiated and be agreed upon by mutual consent. Moreover, they may apply for complementary finance for the

programs from other bodies. Similarly, they may apply for funding from national, regional and from international bodies.

This MoU may be amended or extended by a written document on mutual written consent of The B. H. College and the Marwari Yuva Manch, Barpeta Road Branch, Howly, on approval of the competent authorities.
