



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Guidelines followed for admission into various courses and Scholarship policy

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

Seats will remain reserved subject to availability of applications in the following order

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(i)	S.C.	7%	(ii)	S.T. (Plains)	10%
(iii)	S.T. (Hills)	5%	(iv)	O.B.C. & M.O.B.C.	27%
(v)	Differently abled	3%	(vii)	EWS	10%

RELAXATION OF MARKS:

- The candidates eligible for reservation shall be given relaxation upto 5% of the marks prescribed f_{07} a) admission except for physically handicapped students and students coming from fringe villages.
- Students, who have shown extra-ordinary proficiency in sports etc. at National, Regional, State or Varsity b) level may be offered seats for admission into various courses of studies.
- C) Students having Grade in NCC / Scout.
- d) Descendents of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be admitted irrespective of percentage of marks

REGISTRATION AND MIGRATION:

Registration is compulsory for all students on submission of prescribed forms after admission under A.H.S.E.C. or G.U. and students from Boards or Universities other than S.E.B.A., A.H.S.E.C. or G.U. shall have to produce Migration Certificates at the time of admission.

ATTENDANCE:

Attendance is compulsory in all classes. Students shall be required to attend atleast 75% of lectures for theoretical and practical classes separately to become eligible to sit for the Final Examination, if not, otherwise disqualified for the same.

CANCELLATION OF SEAT:

A student failing to attend classes for 30 (thirty) days at a stretch shall forfeit his or her seat.

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS:

The College follows the regulations prepared by A.H.S.E.C. and G.U. being in force from time to time in respect of concerned courses.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Every pupil of the institution & all Intra-institutional bodies shall be subject to general guidance and control as may be prescribed by the College Governing Body from time to time.
- No student shall be admitted to any course of studies if he or she is found to have indulged in any activity considered detrimental to academic interest.
- 3. A student shall be subject to disciplinary action if he or she is found to be disobedient or indecent in his or her behaviour with the teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 4. A student who is found to have violated College Rules shall be liable to expulsion.
- Only recognised bodies shall have the privilege to use the College Premises after obtaining formal permission from the Principal.
- No notice or leaflet can be circulated anywhere in the College Premises without the approval of the Principal.
- 7. Admission fee and all other fees are to be paid at a time for the whole year on the day of admission.
- Each Academic Session will run as per Academic Calendar embodied in the Prospectus.
- Wearing of College Uniform along with black footwear is compulsory during college hours on all working days including days of College Week, Meetings, Examination etc.
- 10. Students entering the College Compound with armed-security is illegal and subject to disciplinary action.
- 11. The decision of the Principal on all matters relating to students shall be final and binding.
- 12. Mobile Phones are strictly prohibited during class and examination hours. Any violation is subject to severe disciplinary action.
- 13. Spitting/ Smoking/ Writing on walls, doors etc. in and around the college building is strictly prohibited. Any student detected doing so, is subject to expulsion from the college.
- 14. Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- 15. No student in any manner shall be involved in Ragging of any form inside the college campus and the
- 16. However, any student complained of being ragged will also be taken up by the competent authority.
- 17. Committee constituted by the Principal under his Chairmanship will be the competent authority to prohibit ragging or to take any action deem fit for the greater interest of the institution.
- 18. Ragging may invite the following disciplinary actions:
 - Criminal offence as per existing law. 0
 - Rustication from the college. 0
 - Embossment on Marksheet, Certificates etc. 0
 - Penalty and imprisonment of one year. 0

In the event of any complaint regarding ragging no one can plead ignorance to be excused from punitive action.

Admission Procedure

The process of admission into all the courses begins with the notification issued by the Principal immediately after the announcement of respective results. Admission process will be conducted fully through OLINE MODE. Therefore, the intending students are requested to view the COLLEGE WEBSITE for details and admission notification will be uploaded in college website from time to time. The admission will follow on merit basis subject to seats available on the day notified for admission at scheduled time.

ELIGIBILITY NORMS:

The eligibility norms for submission of applications for admission into various courses are as follows:-

- i) H.S.Course (Arts & Com.):
 - H.S.L.C. or equivalent recognised examination with at least 45% marks in aggregate.
- ii) H.S.Course (Science):

H.S.L.C. or equivalent recognised examination with at least 45% marks in aggregate.

iii) T.D.C. (Semester) (Arts, Commerce, Science) FYUGP:

H.S. in concerned stream or equivalent recognised examination with atleast 45% marks in aggregate for General Course (only for Commerce) and at least 50% marks in aggregate for Honours Course.

iv) B.B.A:

H. S. in any stream with at least 45% marks in aggregate.

v) P. G. in Commerce :

B. Com with Major Course or B.Com with atleast 50% marks in aggregate in General Course. It is manadatory to appear in GU Entrance Exam for admission into PG Courses.

vi) P. G. in Assamese & Education :

B. A. with Major in concerned subject with atleast 50% marks in aggregate. It is manadatory to appear in GU Entrance Exam for admission into PG Courses.

N. B.: Admission will be strictly on merit basis. The merit list will be put up on the College Website on the notified date. The merit list is strictly provisional. No candidate can claim for admission just on the ground that his/her application has been accepted and his / her name appears in the merit list. The selected candidate must get admitted on the day of admission.

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Institutions Policy Documents Regarding Scholarship and Freeship for Students

Preamble

The system of scholarship and feeship is an invaluable incentives and affirmative action towards the favour of the economically disadvantaged but meritorious students in their pursuits of a dream career in higher education. It is needless to mention that a large number of students are fulfilling their dreams of pursuing higher education on the strength of economic support received through various scholarship and feeship provided by the central government, state government, various other agencies and the institution itself.

Currently, the students of B.H.College are being semifitted the central government sponsored scholarships like ISHAN UDAN scholarship scheme for the students of North-East region and scholarship for the students of minority community.

Students are also availing the scholarships meant for tribes and communities belonging to the Schedule Tribes (ST), Schedule Cast (SC), Other Backward Cast (OBC).

Besides, the government of Assam for last several years has been providing free admission to the students from a family income of maximum 2 lakhs rupees under the Progyan Bharati Fee Waiver Scheme.

In addition to the above mentioned scholarship and feeship, the college also provides special financial help like research grant, free hostel mess dues to the needy students for the benefits of the students.

The overall outlook of the college is to ensure maximum benefits to the maximum number of students so that no meritorious and needy student is left out in his or her fulfilment of



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dreams in pursuing higher education. The college plays the role of facilitator in providing all these benefits to students who deserve this.

Details of the Scholarship

1. ISHAN UDAN Scholarship

The ministry of HRD and the UGC have taken special interest with regard to promotion of higher education in the North East Region. For improving the gross enrolment ratio, promoting higher education and for encouraging children belonging to economically weaker section of the NE region, the UGC decided to launch "Ishan Udan" special scholarship scheme for NER from the academic session 2014-15.

2. Post Matric Scholarship for ST,SC and OBC students

The government of Assam has been providing these scholarships for the students coming from these specific class and communities as they belong to socially deprived sections. The proper guidelines framed be the competent scholarship awarding are followed by the institution.

3. Post matric Scholarship for the students of Religious Minorities

This is a central government sponsored scheme initiated during the period when Dr. Monmohan Singh was the Prime Minister. Meritorious and economically weak students from the religious minority communities such as Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Jains etc. are the beneficiaries of this scheme. The college provides all facilities to the students in availing these scholarships as per the guideline of the scheme.

4. Financial Support to the Students of NER for higher Professional Courses (NEC Merit Scholarship)

The NEC Merit Scholarship is meant for a limited number of students pursuing higher professional course and deserving students can avail the benefits of this scheme.

5. Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students



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There is the provision for a limited number of scholarships for college and universities students under the central sector scheme for the deserving students and they are provided to the deserving students.

6. Post-Matric Scholarships for Students with Disabilities

There exists provision for special scholarship for the students who are physically challenged (Divyang). Students with disabilities can avail the benefits of this scheme. The College also provides financial help to such students.

7. Begum Hazrat Mahal National Scholarship

Earlier known as Molana Azad National Scholarship Begum Hazrat Mohal National Scholarship is meant for female students from the six notified minority communities. The students reading in classes IX, X, XI and XII can avail are benefits of the scheme.

8. Fee Waiver Scheme of the Government of Assam (Progyan Bharati Fee Waiver Scheme)

Since the academic session 2016-1, a fee waiver scheme has been introduced by the government of Assam under Progyan Bharati for free admission in HS/Degree and MA/M.Sc/M.Com courses under higher education department for those students whose parental income is below Rs. 2 lakhs per year. Students of B.H.College are availing the benefits of the scheme as per the guidelines of the scheme.

9. College Scholarship

The institution also offers certain awards involving cash prize to the distinguished students under the categories given below:

Institution's Role in Scholarship

B.H. College as a higher education institution basically plays the role of facilitator in the release of the scholarship to the deserving students. Most of the scholarships are directly paid to the personal bank account of the concerned students under Direct Bank Transfer (DBF)



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The scholarship branch of the college office offers proper advice and information to the various schemes of scholarship, helps in the verification of documents and submission on uploading of documents. If any anomaly arises during the process, the college immediately takes up the issue with the concerned authority and this to resolve it as soon as possibly for the satisfaction of the students.

In regard to the scholarships/awards instituted by the college, there exists specific criteria and conditions for each award and scholarships. The overall policy of the college is to promote merit and to help the poor and needy students.


