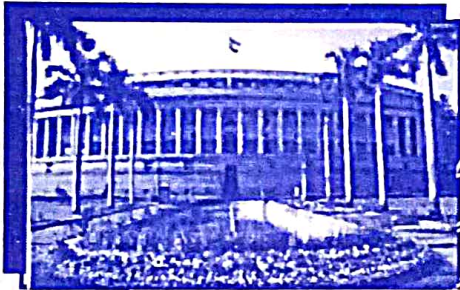
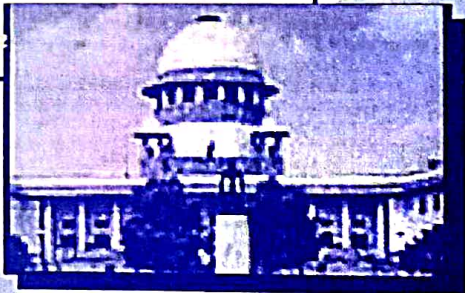

I am glad to learn that B.H. College Political Science Forum is going to publish an annual magazine 'Elite' from this session.

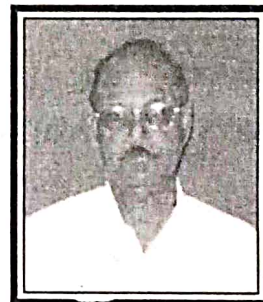
