# **Important Instructions for the Candidates**

**In connection with the Grade-III/IV Recruitment Examination, 2025**

**(B.H.College, Howly)**

**Date of Examination: 16-02-2025 (Shifts: I & II)**

1. The entry gates of the examination centre will be opened for the candidates to enter the college premise at 8.30 am and 11.45 am for Shift-I and Shift-II respectively.
2. The candidates can carry the following items in the examination centre:
  - a. Blue or Black ball point pen
  - b. Transparent water bottle.
  - c. Call Letter for the written test.
  - d. Downloaded Admit Card.
  - e. Photo Identity Proof (Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Driving License, Voter ID or any other valid documents issued by the Central/State Governments).
  - f. Two copies of coloured Passport Sized Photograph.
3. Frisking of the candidates at the entry gate is mandatory before entering into the examination hall.
4. The last times of entry into the examination centre for the candidates are 10.15 am and 1.15 pm for Shift-I and Shift-II respectively.
5. After entering the examination centre, the candidates are asked to view the Display board to find out their Examination Hall No. according to their respective Roll Nos.
6. After reaching the Examination Hall, the candidates are asked to seat according to their Seat Plan arrangement pasted on the front wall of the Examination Halls.
7. During examination hours, the candidates will not be allowed any bio break (e.g., going to toilet, urinal etc.). So candidates are advised to take necessary measures from their end to avoid any inconvenience. As such, no candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before the scheduled time of completion of examination.
8. After completion of the examination, the candidates are strictly asked to leave the examination centre within 11.45 am and 2.45 pm for Shift-I and Shift-II respectively.
9. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Centre In-Charge shall be deemed to be final and binding.
